

## **WORK-STUDY**

The Office of Financial Aid manages the Federal Work-Study (FWS) and Juilliard Work-Study (JWS) programs. FWS is a federally funded program for U.S. Citizens and permanent residents with demonstrated financial need; all other students may work through the JWS program. Unlike other forms of financial aid, payments are made directly to the student twice per month based on the number of hours worked each pay period.

Over 40 different departments employ work-study students. Job opportunities are varied, including administrative support, ushering, giving tours of the school, monitoring auditions and juries, and much more. In addition, there are performance opportunities, such as playing in the Lab Orchestra or one of the Pre-College ensembles; and opportunities for community service and leadership experience, such as the CLIMB tutoring program or becoming a peer mentor for Colloquium class. Students are encouraged to take advantage of any and all jobs that fit their needs and interests.

Job qualifications vary for each job. There are over 400 positions available each year, and pay rates range from \$7.25 to \$15.00 per hour, based on experience and skills.

An on-campus job is not only an opportunity to earn additional money for school; it can be a valuable tool for personal and professional development outside the classroom. It's also a great way to meet new people outside your division, and get to learn more about the inner workings of the school.
